At the March meeting it was decided a letter should go to the school board in reference to the library not being used when it is closed. This has not been an issue the only time library is used is for testing and on Thursdays by the guidance counselor.

New Business:

Summer events have been scheduled for the adults in coordination with the Readsboro Hometown Redevelopment and with the Historical Society. Summer hours were discussed but not finalized.

Mary made a suggestion for a new book for the collection that explores questions about death. "Where Do They Go?" written by Julia Alvarez and artist Sabra Field. Cyndi will check with Bartleby's.

Mary also shared an article about students bringing art to life. If the art teacher was interested Mary said she would seek funding and expertise from the Readsboro Arts group.
