

Readsboro Community Library  
Trustee Meeting  
March 7, 2017@ 1:30 p.m.

Present: AnnaLisa Carew and Mary Angus with Joan O'Donnell via phone. Guests: Cyndi Candiloro, librarian. Meeting called to order at 1:37 p.m. Roll call Molly Frost and Priscilla Margola absent. Joan made a motion to accept agenda with no addition or deletions. AnnaLisa seconded. Approved. Minutes of February 8, 2017 were read. Joan made a motion to approve as read; and AnnaLisa seconded. Approved. Budget status report was presented.

#### Old Business:

Internet was once again discussed. The Board of Trustees had increased the telephone line item for the budget to allow funds for a separate internet line for the library to be in compliance with ALA regulations. However at a budget review with the Select board they voted to not increase the telephone line item but instead to have the librarian purchase a router that would accomplish the same task. The librarian will be checking in to this and will purchase if it suits the intended purpose.

#### New Business:

The library has two adult programs scheduled for this summer and Cyndi has coordinated with both the Historical Society and with the Hometown Redevelopment to use their space for the events. Events will be advertised in Deerfield Valley news, Facebook event created, bimonthly newsletter and fliers.

Library space ~ a letter will be drafted and sent to principal and school board in regard to the library policy; stating that students are not allowed to use the library when the library is not open. Ms. Levy, guidance counselor has permission to use the small room on Thursdays for meeting with her students. With the exception of testing the library is to be locked.

A letter was read from the School Board that was addressed to the Select board in regard to the community librarian providing services to the students. Mary then read a letter that was sent in response to the school board from the select board.

Meeting adjourned at 2:35 p.m. Next meeting will be in April.
