Mary made a motion to accept agenda with no addition or deletions. Annalisa seconded. Approved. Minutes of May 23, 2018 were read. Earlene made a motion to approve as read; and Joan seconded. Approved. Budget status report was presented. The fiscal year ends June 30, 2018 and the library is in good standing.

A thank you from the Vermont Veterans Home for the recent donation of dress shirts for the Veterans in time for Father's Day. A memorial donation for Herbert Sanderson from Richard and Betsy Temple. A thank you will be sent to the donor and to the family of Hebert.
