Addition was added in regard to trustee opening by Mary, seconded by Earlene motion passed. Old Business:

New Business:

2020-2021 budget was discussed between the board members and Mary will be dropping off the proposed budget with Amber.

2020 summer camp at the Readsboro Lions Park is being planned for a fee free camp a minimum of one week in July 2020. Park Carrier, president of the Lions has been called to confirm the use of the park and dates will be set up at a later date.

Community outreach continues with movies at the community center on Tunnel Street twice a month. Some of the residents helped make Veterans Day cards that were sent to each of the Veterans in the community.

Book fair starts on November 18th and will continue through November 30th.

Proceeds from the tree ribbons and the basket/quilt raffles will help pay for a free camp at the Lions Park in July 2020.

The open position on the Board of Trustees will be advertised and letters of interest will be sent to Mary Angus, chairperson. The position will be posted under the glass at the school, town office and the general store. Applicants will be reviewed and voted on at the end of December.
