Old Business:

The door. Carl Newsome gave us a bid quote for a private door to the library. He suggested keeping the main door as it is but to lock the door to the gym and the door to the hallway but, gave us a bid just the same. Door, brick work and moving the heat to actually put in a new door would be \$11,880.00

The quote from Tom Deblois was from 2013 and was \$10,550.00. He would need to take another look and consider today's prices.

New Business:

Cyndi received an e-mail from Sungyull Koo for Rupert, VT. He and his wife Changwa set up the 6.26 Foundation a few years ago. This Foundation is to honor the soldiers who gave their lives in defense of freedom and democracy from communists during the Korean War 1950 – 1953.

They have an annual event on June 25th and this year's recipient was Cpl. Richard Bolognani. They would like to donate \$5,000. that was raised this year to the Library. Their request was that we re-name the Library the "Cpl. Richard Bolognani Library". Cyndi is going to contact them and ask if we could dedicate the Children's room as the "Cpl. Richard Bolognani Children's Room" as changing the name of the Library would mean changing many things ie: tax id, checking account, state forms, etc.

This money could be a great help toward getting the new door. Annalisa suggested that Cyndi also pursue a grant for a new door.

Current Events:

Cyndi was able to coordinate with the School and the Fire Department for Fire Prevention week. The Fire engine came and it was a success as usual. She's also working on a Walking Tour and a Patriotism contest thru the VFW.

The Current programs are Pumpkin carving at the Lion's Park. Kids not in attendance were given a pumpkin to carve at home. The PTG is awarding prizes. There is also a build your won scarecrow and post the pictures on the web site.

November:

Veterans Day cards project (We're Thankful for our Veterans) Card making supplies will be delivered to each family.

Adults:

Game time at the Senior Center is back on! Tuesday evenings and Movie nights have resumed. Cyndi is thinking that Movies should be a Matinée for the winter months so the seniors won't be going home in the dark when it could be slippery.

Budget:

It's time to start looking at the budget for next year. Cyndi suggested the budget remain the same as last year except for a cost of living raise for Normajean who continues to work Thursday from 3:15 to 7:15. Cyndi's hours very and she asked not to have a raise this year.

Meeting place:

The cost of using the church hall is \$50.00 per meeting. Mary suggested that we use the Listers office. We could get a key from Amber as it's a Town owned building and it wouldn't cost us anything.
