We're planning activities, painting fish, making lobsters, bubbles outside, movies etc.

There will also be an evening of painting sea shells for adults July 12th 6:00 – 7:30 and sand dollars in August, date and time to be announced.

Adult summer reading: Cyndi was able to get a few copies of "The Light between Oceans" by M.L. Stedman book discussion August 16th then we'd like to show the movie September 13th at 6:00.

Cyndi renewed the NARM museum pass and was able to get a 2nd card. She explained how this one works and that it gets us into many more places than just buying one from each local museum.

Also, Cyndi was able to get 10 almost new books at a tag sale for \$5.00 and she was able to get another \$500.00 ARPA Grant for technology.
